The event will take place from August 20 to 22, with the participation of renowned researchers from Brazil and the United States.

SAN CARLOS / SP - From August 20 to 22, the “Violence and Conflict Management” seminar will take place at the Federal University of São Carlos (UFSCar), which proposes a debate on topics related to violence, public security, institutional conflict administration, justice and punishment, seeking to interpret existing inequalities in social practices, especially racial inequalities.

The event, organized by the Research Group on Violence and Conflict Management (GEVAC) - from the Department (DS) and the UFSCar Graduate Program in Sociology (PPGS) - will be attended by renowned researchers such as Natalie Byfield, Professor at the Department of Sociology and Anthropology at St. John's University, New York (USA), and scholars at various institutions in the country, such as the federal universities of São Paulo (Unifesp), Rio de Janeiro (UFRJ), Minas Gerais (UFMG), Bahia (UFBA), Ceará (UFC), Rio Grande do Sul (UFRGS) and Fluminense (UFF); University of São Paulo (USP); State University of Campinas (Unicamp); University of Brasília (UnB); Pelotas Catholic University (UCPel) and Pontifical Catholic University of Rio Grande do Sul (PUCRS).
